#### What is REF?

REF is the UK's system for assessing the quality of research in UK higher education institutions. It is undertaken by the four UK higher education funding bodies.

Informs the allocation of around £2 billion government research funding per year

Informs League Table Positions

Provides benchmarking information

Provides accountability for public funding

Attracts Staff and Students



- Occurs every seven years (Last REF was 2014)
- All staff with significant responsibility for research (An inclusive exercise)
- 34 'units of assessment' (UOA). Each UOA covers a subject area such as clinical medicine, engineering, law or history
- Peer review, informed by metrics in some components of the submission
- All material submitted must adhere to strict eligibility criteria and is subject to audit

#### **The Assessment Exercise**





- Each UoA assessment panel uses its professional collective judgement to form an overall quality profile for each UOA. The process is objective and evidence based but is not algorithmic.
- The primary outcome of the panels' work is an **overall quality profile** awarded to each UoA submission.
- The overall quality profile is calculated by applying the sub-profile weightings for Outputs, Impact and Environment.


#### **Quality Thresholds**



Four star	Quality that is world-leading in terms of originality, significance and rigour.
Three star	Quality that is internationally excellent in terms of originality, significance and rigour but which falls short of the highest standards of excellence.
Two star	Quality that is recognised internationally in terms of originality, significance and rigour.
One star	Quality that is recognised nationally in terms of originality, significance and rigour.
Unclassified	Quality that falls below the standard of nationally recognised work. Or work which does not meet the published definition of research for the purposes of this assessment.

A simple measure of the average quality of research, calculated by multiplying the percentage of research in each grade by its rating (0-4), adding them all together and dividing by 100. This is then weighted by the FTE submitted in each unit to reflect the spread of staff.

Performance Measure	2021	2014
Power (weighted GPA x FTE)	718	250

A Power metric provides a better reflection of a truly inclusive submission by factoring in the volume of staff submitted, as well as the quality.




