Our Approach

- Prime consideration - the safety of our staff and students.
- Consultation with Scottish Government, NHS Lothian, Health Protection Teams
- Specialist expert advice to supplement Health & Safety team and engaged actively TUs
- Reduced capacity of teaching, study, public spaces two metre social distancing
- Physical changes, new services, new equipment
 - *Perspex screens, hand sanitisation stations, PPE, signage*
- Additional teaching spaces – EICC and Murrayfield stadium
- All teaching spaces and study spaces reconfigured to ensure 2 metre distancing
- Shared plans with Scottish Government and the Health & Protect teams - review

The Golden Rules

- Don't come to campus if you or someone in your household has Covid-19 symptoms
 - *Self-isolate & get a test*
 - www.nhsinform.scot
 - *Covid Health Helpline launching soon*
- Maintain two metre distance from each other when on campus
- Wash your hands regularly and use the hand sanitiser and wipes provided
- Wear a face covering on campus in public spaces

These behaviours will keep you safe and ensure that people are not in 'close contact' as defined by the Test and Protect guidelines.

What you need to do

- Complete Moodle Training – appropriate H&S guidance
- Use the hand sanitisers and wipes, ensure students use them to keep desks/study places clean
- Scan the iNapier QR codes at entrances to each building so we know you are on campus
- Follow the one way systems in buildings
- Use Resource Booker facility to book spaces in the library or to use a hot desk
- Follow guidance for use of multiple-occupancy rooms, to be published this week
- Use Click & Collect services to buy drinks and food or to obtain a book from the library
- Maintain two metre social distancing at all times (collecting food, enter rooms, using the toilets)
- Use the all the resources available to help you – DLTE, IS, HR etc

Keep checking communications

Remember

- Only come to campus if you have a scheduled on-campus activity or agreed with your line manager
- Don't arrange to meet visitors on campus
- Don't forget the Golden Rules!
 - *Always maintain a two metre distance from each other*
 - *Wash your hands regularly and use the hand sanitiser provided*
 - *Face coverings*
