Access Requirements

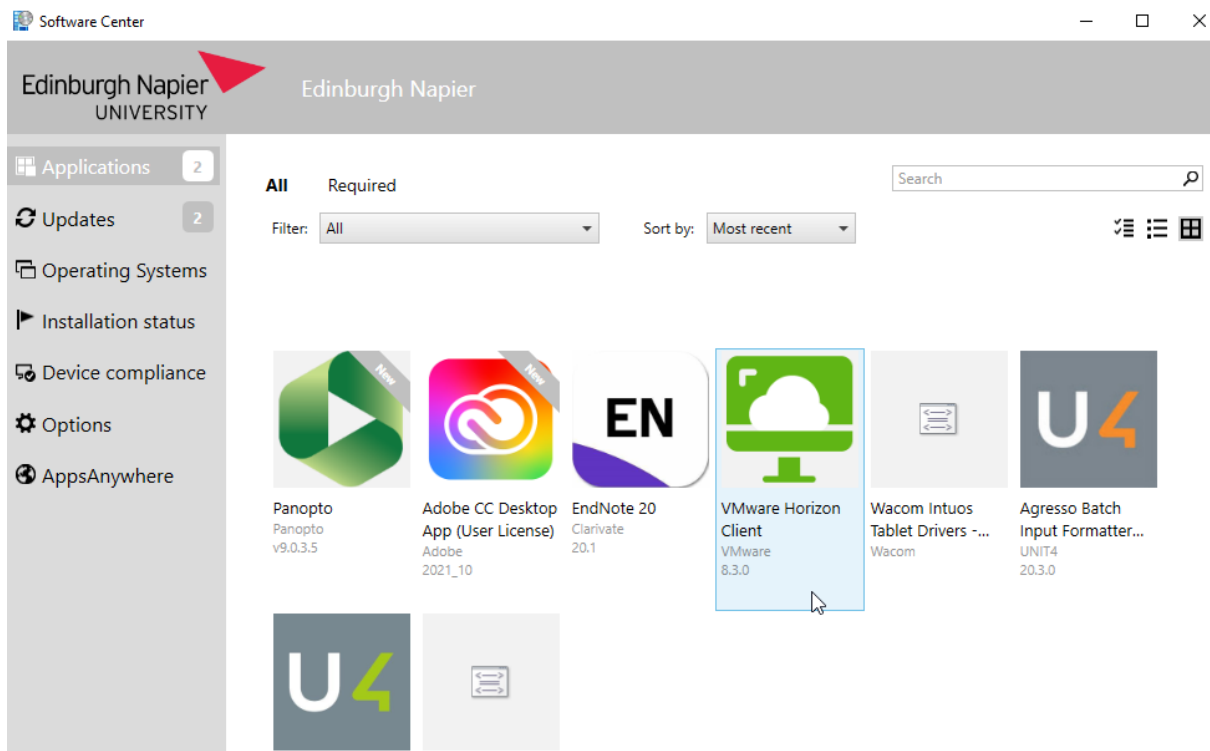
SITS Account:

You will need a live SITS account to access SITS Vision Live (Remote). Details on requesting access can be found on the [SITS User Access](#) UniDesk form. Academics should request access on the [SITS Academic User Access](#) UniDesk form.

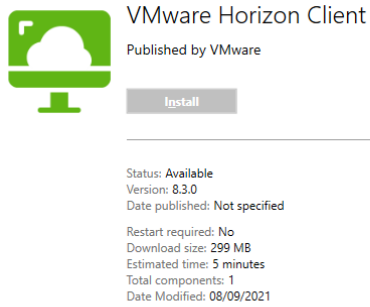
VMWare Horizon Client:

Access to SITS Vision Remote is through a piece of software called VMware Horizon Client. If you don't have this installed on your managed laptop, you can find the installation file now through the Software Centre on your laptop. Search for and open **Software Centre**, then select **Applications**.

- Click on **VMware Horizon Client**



- Click Install

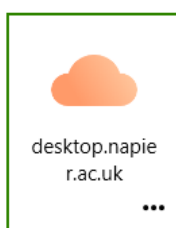


Accessing SITS Vision Live (Remote)


- Once VMware Horizon Client has been installed on your computer, you should see the following icon on your desktop. Open **VMware Horizon Client**



- Click the **desktop.napier.ac.uk** icon




- Enter your Edinburgh Napier **Username** and **Password** and click **Login**



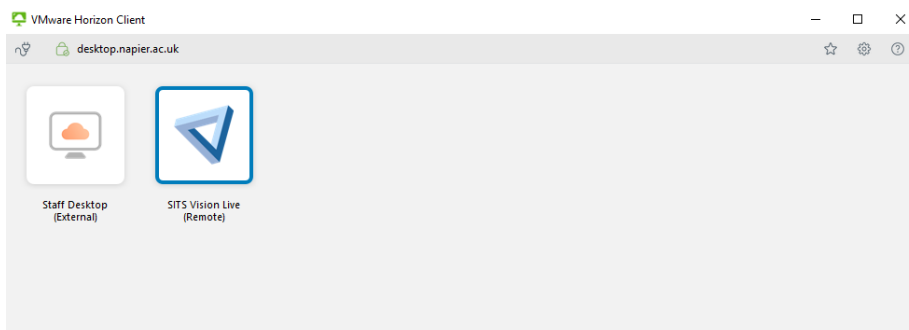



- When prompted, please click **Add Server**



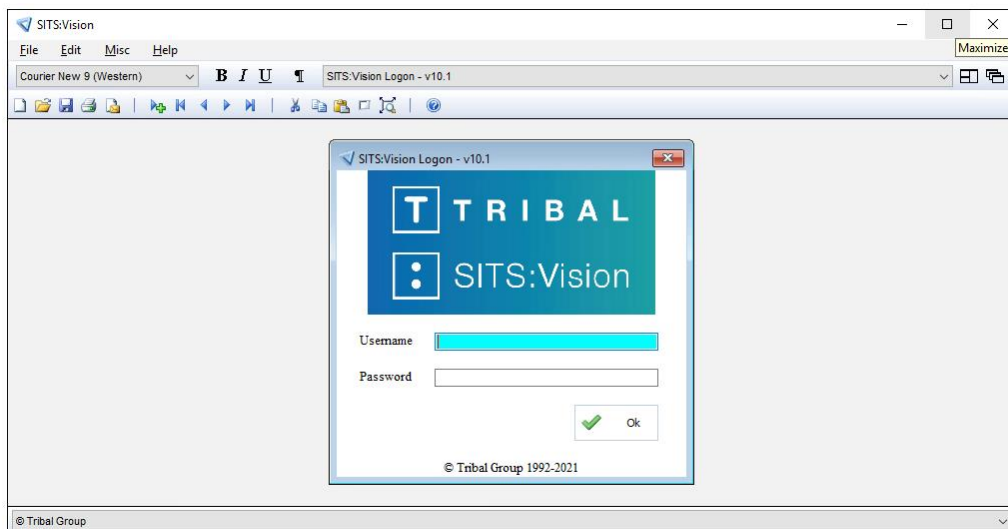
- Enter **desktop.napier.ac.uk** and then **Connect**

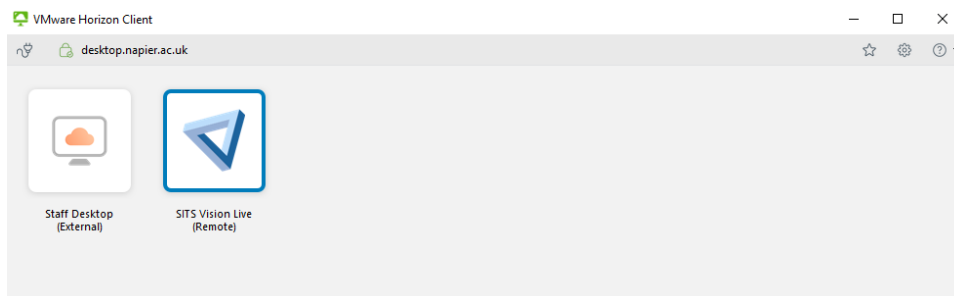
SITS VISION LIVE (REMOTE)

TOP TIPS

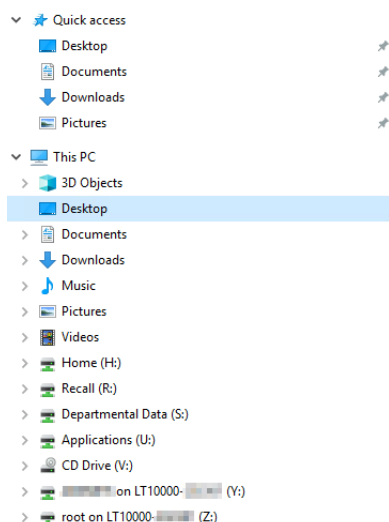
- You can open multiple versions of the client by clicking on the SITS Remote icon in VMware Horizon Client



- If you have created a shortcut during the setup above, you will be able to quickly access SITS Vision Live (Remote) from the desktop.

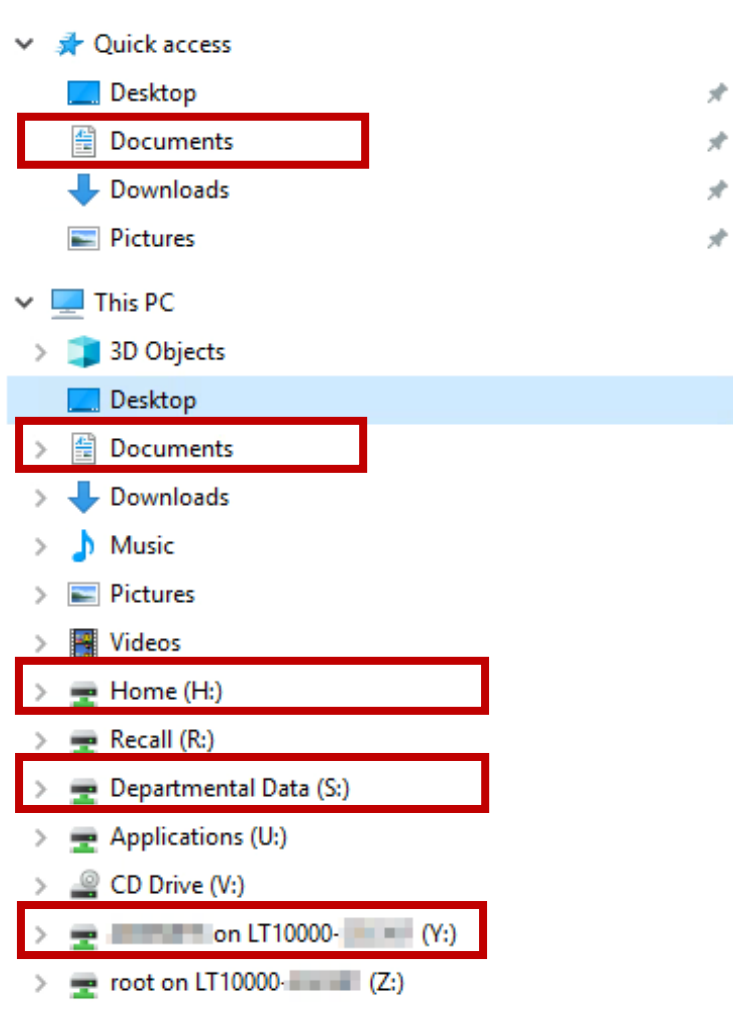


- Importing and Exporting. If you have access to Import or Export SITS data, you will notice a slight difference to the folder options.



As you are connected to a server on the university network, you will need to be mindful of where you are storing or grabbing your file from. The options above are illustrative of the account used for the screen shots, but you will see a similar structure.

If a folder doesn't open for you double check you are using one of the folders that are available to you:



Selecting your ID number and PC name (Y:) will open the folder structure on your own device.
