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Restricted areas

Access to the following areas is restricted:

- rooms or areas accommodating plant
- mains electrical switchgear
- lift machinery
- heating and ventilation equipment
- central heating boilers
- confined spaces
- roof areas
- IT server rooms
- certain other areas such as containment from asbestos or other hazardous atmospheres, areas with radiation sources etc.

Only authorised members of staff and contractors are permitted to enter such rooms.

Contracted work

Any contracted work in these areas must be controlled under permits to work/access and these will be completed by the school, service or Property & Facilities dependent on who controls the area or risk associated with it.

Access to these areas is controlled mainly via Property & Facilities and they will provide the necessary permits and controlled access keys via security on site.

Where it is managed by a school or other service, they will provide the necessary paperwork, authorisation, and access.

Only competent contractors who have been inducted and signed the <u>Control of Contractor Code of Practice</u> will be able to access these areas to carry out any necessary works.

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
