Summary – Workplace (Health, Safety & Welfare) Regulations

Workplace means any premises or part of premises which are not domestic premises and are made available to any person as a place of work. A modification, extension or a conversion shall not be regarded as a workplace or form part of a workplace until the modification, extension or conversion is complete.

This policy covers Workplace Health Safety and Welfare requirements covering the following areas.

- Maintenance of workplace, equipment, devices and systems
- Ventilation temperature in indoor workplaces
- Lighting
- Cleanliness and waste material
- Room dimensions
- Workstation and seating
- Condition of floors and traffic routes
- Falls and falling objects
- Windows, transparent or translucent doors, gates and walls
- Windows, skylights and ventilators
- Cleaning windows
- Organisation etc. of traffic routes
- Doors and gates
- Sanitary conveniences
- Washing facilities
- Drinking water
- Accommodation for clothing
- Facilities for changing clothes
- Facilities for rest and meals
- Allocation of responsibilities
