Following the implantation of the <u>Napier pay offer</u>, your March payslips are now available to review on <u>HR connect</u> <u>Self Service</u>.





Basic Pay- will show your new monthly pay taking into account the accelerated increment point. (Service-related increments will continue to be applied as normal on top of this).

Basic Pay (Back Pay) -The backdated pay element reflects the additional increment applied from 01 October 2022 (or your start date if after this date) and you will see a breakdown for each month when you select the ³.
