## Browser Only

The majority of the University's online services can be accessed directly via a browser on your home PC.  
**Use a browser where possible.**

## Use a browser on your home PC to access:

### Office 365 Apps:

- Email
- Word, Excel, PowerPoint
- SharePoint, OneDrive
- Teams

### Most University Websites

- Moodle
- Webex
- University Software

## Virtual Private Network (VPN)

Install the VPN Client on your home PC to create a secure connection to the network. It enables you to log in to password protected University websites and connect to your office PC via a Remote Desktop Connection (RDC). **Learn more: [bit.ly/EdNapVPN](http://bit.ly/EdNapVPN)**

## Virtual Desktop Service (VDS)

Install VMware Horizon Client to create a virtual desktop on the University network. It enables you to access files on your H and S drives. However it can be slow and does not offer a good video calling experience. You can also access your H / S drives via the VPN and a RDC. **Learn more: [bit.ly/EdNapSVDS](http://bit.ly/EdNapSVDS)**
