In response to student feedback, we **extended Library opening hours** throughout the exam periods and over the Easter holidays.

To make it easier for busy students living in Edinburgh Napier student accommodation, we created **special Library drop boxes** at Bainfield, Slateford Road and Orwell Terrace residences. This allows students to return books without coming to campus.

We continued to refurbish the **Lecture Theatres and Classrooms**, replacing the Audio-Visual (AV) facilities, and adding new teaching desks.
