<b>Number of users</b>	Unlimited.
<b>Mobile friendly (online)</b>	Good reading experience on iPad/iPad mini. Resizes on iPad mini and iPhone.
<b>How much can I download?</b>	A chapter at a time.
<b>Full book download</b>	No.
<b>Chapter download.</b>	Yes. Save PDF.
<b>iPhone/iPad mini/iPad: chapter download</b>	PDFs can be opened in a variety of different applications. Tap screen, then Open in... iPhone best viewed landscape.
<b>Ebook readers/Kindle/Kindle app: chapter download</b>	On chapter home page, "More options", select eReader format (ePub or Mobipocket). For Kindle, download to Kindle app on iPad: tap screen > Open in > Copy to Kindle. Download as PDF to pc/laptop. Transfer to Kindle via USB lead. iPhone best viewed landscape.
<b>How much can I print?</b>	A chapter at a time.
<b>More printing info</b>	Open PDF and print. Double-sided printing possible.
<b>Email link/social networking options</b>	No.
<b>Search within chapter</b>	On chapter home page, use browser find functionality. Use PDF search functionality to search downloaded chapters.
<b>Make notes</b>	Download PDF. Use functionality to highlight, add sticky notes or annotate within the text.
<b>Reference tools</b>	No.
<b>Export to EndNote</b>	From chapter home page, save to Mendeley or Refworks, or export as RIS to EndNote. On networked pcs on campus, "save and open" causes EndNote desktop to open. Otherwise, save the file as .enw or .ris and import into the online version of EndNote; or email the file to your Napier email and import into EndNote desktop version when on campus.
<b>Read aloud</b>	Save chapter to pc. Open PDF file, activate read aloud, click View, then Read out loud.
<b>Password system</b>	Use your Edinburgh Napier login (EZproxy).
<b>Other information</b>	Lot 2 ebooks. Leased not owned.
