



To access Library resources on and off campus (e.g. home or work), you will need to use your University login. Once logged in (e.g. to a particular resource, a university PC or Moodle), you should not have to log in again, as long as you use the specially created eresource links in LibrarySearch (<http://librarysearch.napier.ac.uk>). To see all available eresources, log into Library Search by clicking the Sign In link on the home page.

Find a specific ejournal

- Go to [LibrarySearch](#) and select Journal Search.
- Enter the title of the journal you are looking for and hit return.
- Click on the journal title to link to the journal and to find any non-standard instructions.

Finding a specific database

- Go to [LibrarySearch](#) and select Databases.
- Enter the database name, and click Go (or choose a subject from All Subjects).
- Click the database name to access it. Any non-standard instructions will be in the database list.

Searching for an ebook

- Search for books using [LibrarySearch](#).
- Enter your keywords and click Search.
- Limit your search to ebooks by selecting from the filters on the right:
 - Full text Online (under Availability)
 - Books (under Format)

How do you know if you are logged in?

It's not always easy to tell if you have successfully logged in to a database.

Sometimes, but not always, you may see clues, such as the University name/logo at the top of the page or "ezproxy.napier.ac.uk" in the web address.
