Privacy Policy Guidance


This guide explains how to set up a Privacy Policy notice for your Microsoft Bookings page.



To set your Microsoft Bookings page to display the Privacy Policy notice:

- From your Bookings homepage, click **Business Information** and locate the **Privacy Policy URL** section.
- Copy the following link into the Privacy policy URL text field: http://staff.napier.ac.uk/dpstatements
- Click **Save** at the top of the page:



- From your Booking page go to the **Customer Data Usage Consent section** and click on the **checkbox**: "Show a personal data collection and usage...".
- Copy the following statement into the Customer data usage consent text box: "I have read and understood the Privacy Policy. Please refer to the MS Bookings privacy notice using the Privacy Policies link below".
- Click **Save** at the top of the page.



When you click on your Booking Page link, your Booking Page will be displayed where you will be able to see your set appointments.

At the bottom of the page the Privacy Policy consent terms and check box should be displayed.

The Privacy Policies link is displayed below the Book button. It will direct you to <u>ENU's Privacy Notices page</u> where the Microsoft Bookings notice is listed.
