

Flexibly Managed Programmes Guidance

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Purpose

1. The purpose of this guidance is to provide an operational framework:
 - a) to enable schools to approve flexible programme structures which include modules approved by more than one school and corresponding award titles
 - b) to manage the learning experience of students undertaking a flexibly managed programme.

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Ownership and management

2. The procedure is overseen by Quality & Standards Committee and managed and led locally by the School Academic Lead for Quality Enhancement.
3. The process for designing, developing and approving a flexibly managed programme of study is devolved to schools.

Flexibly managed programmes

4. A flexibly managed programme contains modules from more than one school with the balance of study being overtly cross-school.
5. Modules within each stage of study are proposed by individual students to suit their specific learning needs. Students work with a member of staff to build their programme of study into a unique coherent structure which meets University regulations.
6. Flexibly managed programmes do not have compulsory modules as students are, in principle, able to draw upon the entire University module catalogue. However, as some modules can only be offered to students who have met specific pre-requisite admission requirements or to students studying an accredited programme of study, the selection of modules studied will be negotiated and agreed with appropriate school support staff and not individual students in isolation. While students who meet the entry criteria for a module may study that module admission to a module cannot be guaranteed.



7. The overall learning outcomes and objectives of a programme must be coherent and meaningful and practically this will direct student choice to groups of subject specific modules. This will ensure that programme structures contain an appropriate volume of underpinning subject specific content to enable award titles to be approved which take account of relevant subject benchmark statement requirements.
8. This procedure recognises that knowledge and skills can be acquired from a range of learning experiences, both formal and informal. In determining a student's admission point to a flexibly managed programme school support staff will make use of the University's recognition of prior learning procedure which allows certificated or uncertificated prior learning to be recognised. However, recognised prior learning will not contribute in decisions on an award title which will be determined only from the modules studied at Edinburgh Napier University.

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Procedure outline

9. This procedure is the means by which the University ensures that:
 - a) the academic standard of all flexibly managed programmes which lead to an award of the University is set and maintained at an appropriate level and in accordance with University expectations
 - b) the quality of the learning experience offered to all students enrolled on a flexibly managed programme is enhanced in accordance with University expectations.
10. The procedure has three components: the admissions of students to a programme, initial approval of a programme structure and award title and approval of final award title. The admissions process is managed and implemented by school staff. Initial approval of programme structures and award titles and approval of the final award title is overseen by the School Academic Lead for Quality.

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The admissions process

11. Students may enter a flexibly managed programme at Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF) levels 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 and where the balance of their study is overtly cross-school. The point of entry will be determined by each student's individual learning profile. This profile will be reviewed during a meeting with a member of school staff. Account will be taken of prior certificated learning or through the University's established mechanisms to recognise uncertificated prior or experiential learning. In determining the point of entry to a programme full account will be given to the University's academic regulations and Admissions Policy.
12. While students who meet the entry criteria for a module may study that module, admission to any module cannot be guaranteed without consulting the module leader or an appropriate administrator in the relevant school.
13. The outcome of the meeting will be that a student is accepted as a student studying a flexibly managed programme. A programme structure in the form of a coherent set of modules to be taken in the student's first stage of study and an indicative award title will be agreed. Alternatively, where the balance of study is mainly within one school, the student will be advised to contact a school admissions officer to discuss a subject specific programme more relevant to their learning profile.

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Initial approval of a programme structure and award title

14. Having been offered a place on a flexibly managed programme the student will be enrolled on the relevant number of modules to suit their chosen mode of study, that is, full-time or part-time. Indicative award titles will be approved by the School Learning, Teaching & Assessment Committee as close to the start of a student's period of study as possible.
15. By the end of Week 5 in each trimester a member of school staff will meet with individual students to ensure that a programme plan is in place setting out the modules to be taken in the current stage of study which will then be entered on the student's record. The appropriateness of the programme structure and the



student's initial award title will then be considered and recorded by the School Learning, Teaching & Assessment Committee. In subsequent trimesters the modules to be studied in each following stage of study will be routinely agreed by school staff and the student in a programme plan and considered by the School Learning, Teaching & Assessment Committee.

16. Provisional award titles and programme structures will be reviewed by the School Learning, Teaching & Assessment Committee each trimester to ensure that each student's programme of study is following a coherent pattern of study as defined in Appendices 2 and 3.

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Approval of the final award title

17. A student's final award title will be approved by the School Learning, Teaching & Assessment Committee at its meeting in the trimester preceding the student's planned final trimester of study. In the event of unforeseen changes to a student's planned programme of learning after the start of their final trimester of study the School Learning, Teaching & Assessment Committee will how this might affect the final award title as appropriate. The outcome will be that a member of school support staff will update the student's personal record with the approved modules within the programme structure and the approved final award title.
18. Figure 1 provides a diagrammatical representation of student life cycle from application to graduation from a flexibly managed programme.

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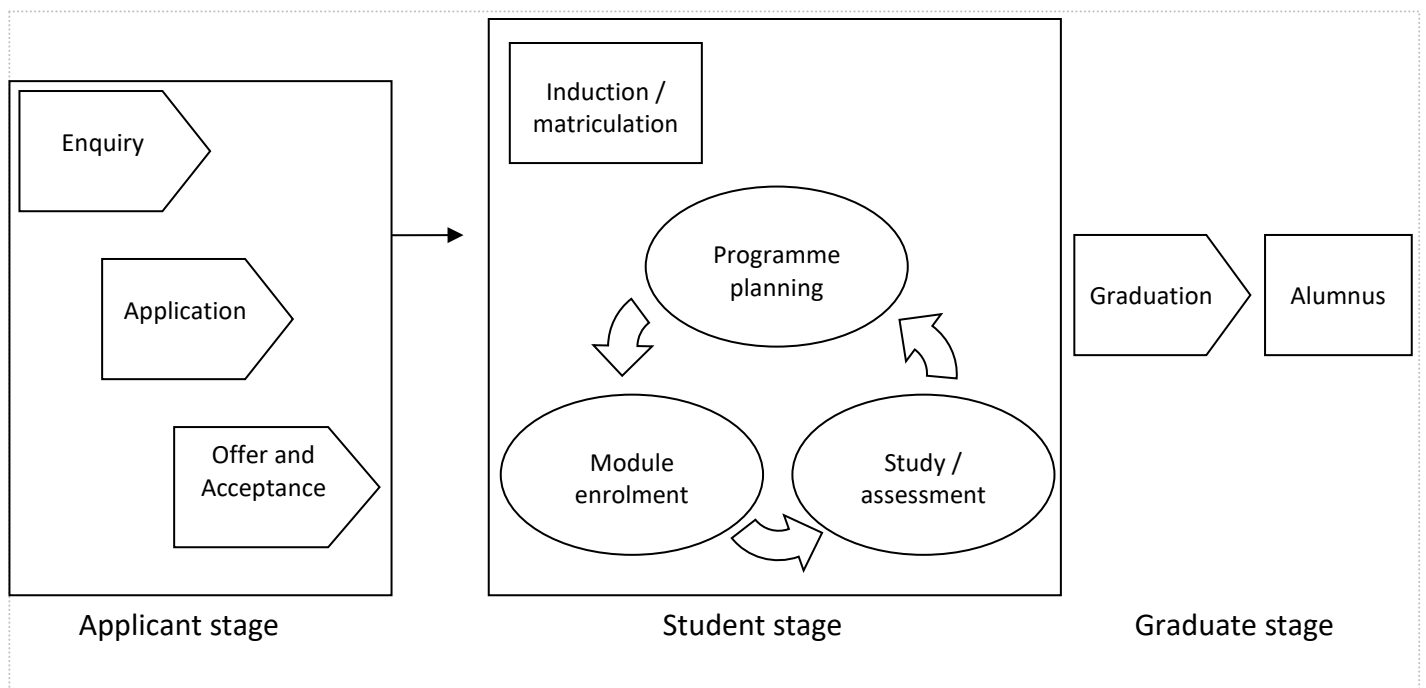
Quality assurance and enhancement arrangements

19. All awards of the University achieved by students studying a flexibly managed programme are fit for purpose, are included within and governed by the University's academic regulations and meet University expectations. This is achieved through implementing the bespoke procedures set out in this section of the procedure.



20. All modules used in flexibly managed programmes will be existing approved University modules and their quality assurance therefore resides in the parent school.

Programme award title and structure design rules for flexibly managed programmes

21. The structure of all flexibly managed programmes which lead to an award of the University must be based on the following design rule:
 - an approved programme structure must include approved modules from two or more schools are in sufficient volume and level of credit to influence the title of the intended award.
22. The content of a flexibly managed programme will determine the subject areas identified in the title of the award achieved by successful students. For conventional school-based programmes with two subject components the award title for a bachelor's degree with honours is governed by the balance of compulsory and option modules which must be within minimum and maximum limits set out in the University's academic regulations. The title of an award achieved by successful students completing a flexibly managed programme is determined using equivalent minimum and maximum credit and subject requirements for any award of the University as set out in Appendix 1.

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Availability of awards of the University

23. Given the programme structure design rule set out in this procedure the following restrictions on the availability of awards of the University from flexibly managed programmes apply:
 - a) Undergraduate awards of the University.
 - a programme structure leading to a joint award of a graduate certificate cannot be approved as the minimum volume of credit for a joint award is 60 credits in each subject component
 - where modules from three or more schools are included in a programme structure leading to a joint award of a certificate of higher education cannot be approved as the minimum volume of credit for a joint award is 60 credits in each subject component



- where modules from three or more schools are included in a programme structure leading to a combined award of a graduate certificate cannot be approved as the minimum volume of credit for the major and minor components in a combined award is 40 credits and 20 credits respectively in each subject component
- where modules from three or more schools are included in a programme structure leading to a joint award of a graduate diploma cannot be approved as the minimum volume of credit for a joint award is 60 credits in each subject component
- by exception the School Learning, Teaching & Assessment Committee may approve a generic award title. In such cases a student will have successfully achieved the minimum volume of credit at the level of the award in accordance with University academic regulations but the volume of subject-specific credit will be insufficient to merit a subject-specific award to be conferred.

Examples of generic award titles include:

- i) Certificate of Higher Education by Flexibly Managed Study
- ii) Graduate Certificate by Flexibly Managed Study.

b) Taught master's awards of the University

- a programme structure leading to a single subject award of the University cannot be approved as single subject awards of the University are only available through school-managed provision
- a programme structure leading to a joint award of a postgraduate certificate cannot be approved as the minimum volume of credit for a joint award is 60 credits in each subject component
- where modules from three or more schools are included a programme structure leading to a combined award of a postgraduate certificate cannot be approved as the minimum volume of credit for the major and minor components in a combined award is 40 credits and 20 credits respectively in each subject component



- where modules from three or more schools are included a programme structure leading to a joint award of a postgraduate diploma cannot be approved as the minimum volume of credit for a joint award is 60 credits in each subject component
- where modules from three or more schools are included a programme structure leading to a joint award of a master's degree cannot be approved as the minimum volume of credit for a joint award is 80 credits in each subject component
- by exception the School Learning, Teaching & Assessment Committee may approve a generic award title. In such cases a student will have successfully achieved the minimum volume of credit at the level of the award in accordance with University academic regulations but the volume of subject-specific credit will be insufficient to merit a subject-specific award to be conferred. Examples of generic award titles include:
 - i) Postgraduate Certificate by Flexibly Managed Study
 - ii) Master's Degree by Flexibly Managed Study.

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Approving award titles

24. Proposed award titles resulting from successful completion of a flexibly managed programme will be considered and approved by the School Learning, Teaching & Assessment Committee, taking account of:
- the programme award title and structure design rules for taught award or credit-bearing programmes
 - the level and volume of SCQF credit and the subjects studied by the student at Edinburgh Napier University
 - the subject specific learning outcomes achieved by each student at the level of the award and their relationship to relevant subject and qualification benchmark statements
 - existing approved titles of awards of the University



- professional, statutory and regulatory body requirements and expectations to ensure that award titles conferred do not conflict with or imply that any exemption, recognition or fitness to practise has been granted
- case history arising from the approval of flexibly managed award titles.

25. Successful completion of a flexibly managed programme will lead to one of the following awards of the University as a joint subject award or a combined subject award providing that full account has been taken of relevant University academic regulations. Exit awards will be conferred in accordance with University regulations. Minimum and maximum subject and credit requirements for an undergraduate award of the University are set in Appendix 3 and for a taught master's award of the University in Appendix 4. The following awards are available:

- a certificate of higher education
- a certificate of higher education with distinction
- a diploma of higher education
- a diploma of higher education with distinction
- a bachelor's degree
- a bachelor's degree with distinction
- a graduate certificate
- a graduate certificate with distinction
- a graduate diploma
- a graduate diploma with distinction
- a bachelor's degree with Honours
- a postgraduate certificate
- a postgraduate certificate with distinction
- a postgraduate diploma
- a postgraduate diploma with distinction



- a master’s degree
 - a master’s degree with distinction.
26. Alternatively, a student who successfully achieves a recognised volume of credit through completing an approved SCQF level 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 module or modules, but has not satisfied the requirements for an award of the University, may be awarded a certificate of credit.
27. The title of all awards of the University resulting from a flexibly managed programme will be distinct from those available in any school. Proposed award titles will be subject to review by the school where the majority of a student’s studies are located.

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Transferring into a flexibly managed programme

28. Students may transfer to a flexibly managed programme from other school programmes subject to meeting the necessary admission requirements in accordance with University academic regulations.

Appendix 2: Undergraduate awards of the University

Given the programme structure design rules set out in this guidance, single subject awards of the University are only available through school-managed provision.

1. Permitted flexibly managed programme structures where approved modules from two schools are included

A joint subject award of the University where approved modules from two schools are included

1.1a A bachelor's degree with honours (Diagrams 1, 2, 3 and 4)

A minimum of 160 credits and a maximum of 220 credits at SCQF levels 7, 8, 9 and 10 in each subject of which a minimum of 40 credits at SCQF level 10 in one subject must be derived from a dissertation or final year project. The title of the award would be a *Bachelor's Degree with Honours in Subject A1 and Subject B1* or a *Bachelor's Degree with Honours in Subject B1 and Subject A1*.

The minimum of 40 credits at SCQF level 10 which must be derived from a dissertation or final year project can be provided by either School A or School B but must be part of the major component.

Exit awards will be conferred in accordance with University regulations. Exit award titles will take account of the criteria set out in this guidance.

1.2a A bachelor’s degree with honours (Diagrams 9, 10, 11 and 12)

A minimum of 240 credits and a maximum of 300 credits at SCQF levels 7, 8, 9 and 10 in the major subject component of which a minimum of 40 credits at SCQF level 10 must be derived from a dissertation or final year project and a minimum of 100 credits and a maximum of 140 credits at SCQF levels 7, 8, 9 and 10 in the minor component. The title of the award would be a *Bachelor’s Degree with Honours in Major subject with Minor subject*.
